The COVID and Adolescent Development Dataverse (CADD) serves an expanding global community of scholars who seek to understand the current and long-term impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on youth development around the world and to use that information to support resilience and healing in diverse communities.

CADD was developed by the Society for Research on Adolescence (SRA) and the SRA COVID-19 Response Team, launched in the summer of 2020. Joining with the International Coalition on Centers for Developmental Science, the SRA Covid-19 Response Team works to better understand and disseminate information about the impact of the pandemic on adolescent development, in ways that extend far beyond the disease itself. One component of this team's efforts is to ignite international collaboration to further this goal.

Through CADD, the SRA COVID-19 Response Team invites all scholars interested in youth development and COVID to engage in collaborations either by advertising opportunities for collaboration in CADD and/or by contacting those with relevant data and opportunities to pursue collaboration.

2. You may search CADD using the FIND window or expand your search for specific fields using the advanced search option. Under advanced search options you may select features of dataset, including what countries are assessed in a given dataset, specific keyword terms, and more.
3. Datasets that fit search terms will be listed and allow you to open records to learn more details about each dataset. Within each record you will find contact information to learn more about the data from its owner. We are encouraging everyone to upload a codebook or list of constructs and measures as well as any procedures they want to follow for dataset inquiries and agreements.
4. CADD is one of many dataverses that are managed by UNC within this larger dataverse structure, so you can also search for other data here. This is the same type of platform as supported by Havard, but they manage different dataverses.
